

Do you read the bulletin? I will admit that I have never made a habit of reading the bulletin of any parish I have belonged to in my adult life. But I have come to realize how important the bulletin is for communication in a parish. Shortly after arriving at Sacred Heart it was brought to my attention how limited we were by only having two pages to share current news and information. After much research and review by staff

(with special thanks to Laura Gillis and Michelle Frazzetta), I am excited to announce that we are now using Diocesan Publications for our bulletins! Diocesan representative, Dave Laney, has worked hard to secure funding from advertisers (please see back cover pages) in order to make this bulletin possible. Dave and the support personnel from Diocesan have helped us utilize the many new features that their services offer.

Here are a few benefits and new features of this bulletin:

The Cover: In the past we ordered bulletins in bulk, which meant having a preset cover and advertisements page. Each week we would run bulletins through the copy machine to print on the inside. This seriously limited our space and prevented us from updating some important information on the first page that readers would see, namely the cover. Our previous order was placed last summer when I first arrived. If we recognize that the cover is the "first impression" opportunity for any publication, you can see how being locked in for nine months would be restricting. With Diocesan Publications we will have access to a variety of templates relating to every season of the liturgical calendar. We also have the ability to customize and personalize our covers with images from around our own campus and parish events!

Pictures are worth a thousand words. Beyond the cover, we will have the ability to create images to advertise future events and share pictures from events after they are over (e.g. fun pictures from Trivia Night that show some of the life on our campus). We can use icons and images to help readers quickly find information from various ministries. We can even

share photos of recent Baptisms, Weddings, Confirmations and First Communions!

Pastor's column and catechesis: The staff and I will use the bulletin to communicate parish news and how to be involved within the parish. Diocesan Publications also supplies regular content for catechesis that we can add from time to time.

Evangelization: Obviously the bulletin's main purpose is to communicate to the parish all current events. But I want to challenge you to consider opportunities for evangelization. While reading through the bulletin consider if any events or information might be useful to others who are not parishioners at Sacred Heart. Would your friends in area parishes be enriched by joining some of our events? Are there events that you can invite non-Catholics to join you in attending? Along with this, I ask that when you travel and visit other Catholic churches that you please grab an extra bulletin to share with me. This opens up creativity and new ideas for our own bulletin.

There's an app for that: Along with the bulletin, Diocesan provides a great app customized for our parish. Please see the advertisement for more information. And, of course, download the app!

- -Sick children who possess enough maturity of reason to benefit from the sacrament






